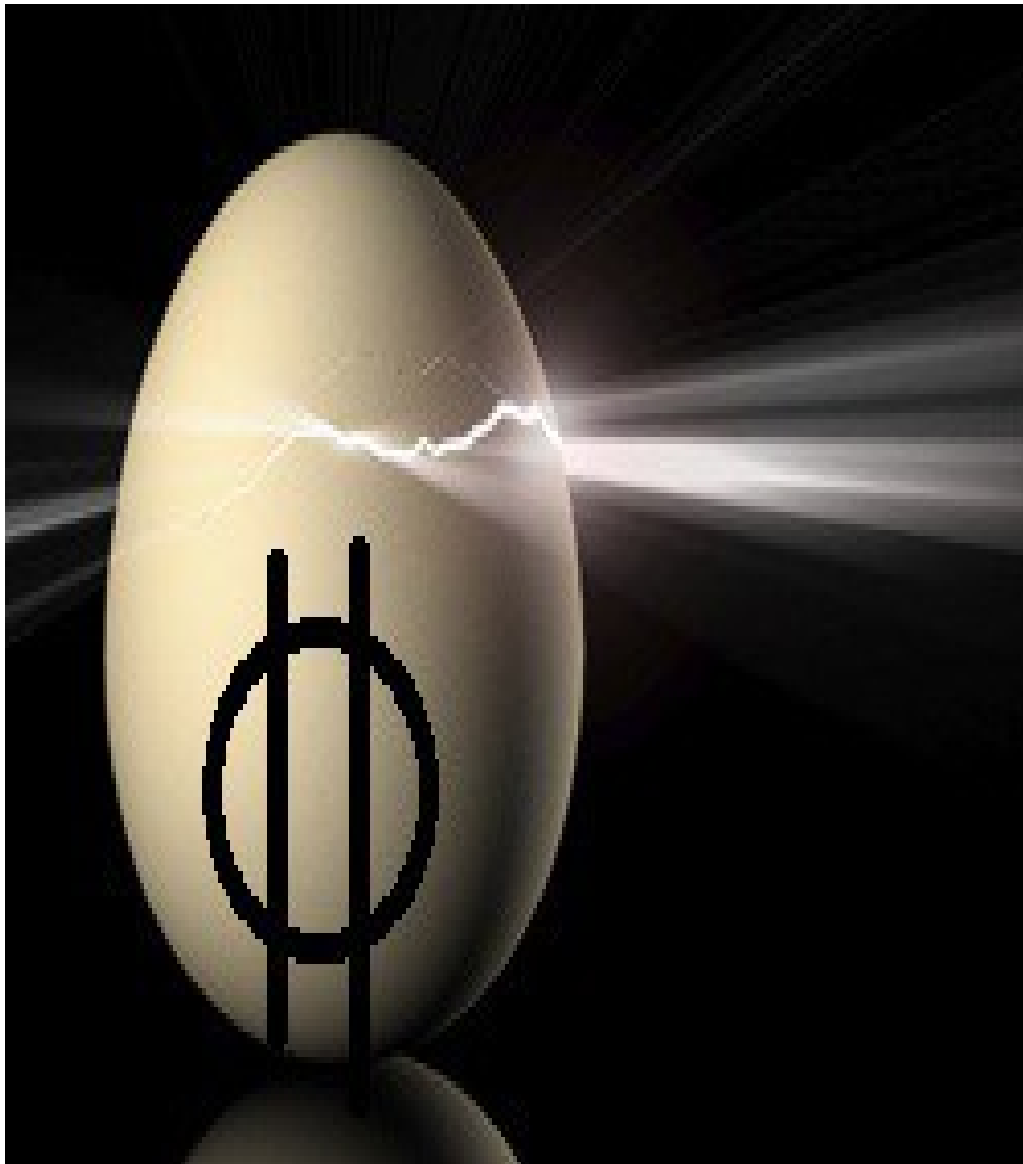


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Letter From the Editor

Seasonal Almanac

Today is Samhain, Calen Gaef, or November 1, 2012 CE. It is the 1st Day of the 7th Year of the 2nd Age of the Druid Reform.

The Feast of Samhain began at Sunset on October 31st. (Some Druids may celebrate on November 7th, when the Sun reaches 15 degrees Scorpio, the midpoint between the Autumnal Equinox and the Winter Solistice)

It is the 1st day of the Season of Geimredh, and the 1st day of the Month of MÌ na Samhna. It is also Thursday, in the common tongue, or Dydd Lau in Welsh.

It is the Druidic day of the Oak.

4 Geimredh -- Daylight Savings Time Ends -- Turn clock back 1 hour

13 Geimredh - NEW MOON

15 Geimredh - Birthday of OMS Patriarch Emeritus and Co-Founder, Sybok Pendderwydd

22 Geimredh - The Sun enters Sagittarius.

22 Geimredh- Druish Feast of Bori Gormod Dwrci Dddiwrnod

24 Geimredh- Birthday of Celtic Bard and Honorary Druid, Robin Williamson.

28 Geimredh - Full "Beaver" Moon

30 Geimredh - Birthday of Honorary Druid Oberon Zell-Ravenheart. 31 Geimredh - Me·n Geimhridh (December) begins (a Satyrday - Dydd Sadwrn - Day of the Sequoia)

41 Geimredh - NEW MOON

51 Geimredh - Yule / Alban Arthuan, or the Winter Solstice. The Sun enters Capricorn.

Being the 7th Year of the 2nd Age of the Druid Reform

As of today 762 Druids have registered with the RDG:

39 members are initiated Second Order Druids

29 members are ordained Third Order Druids (Clergy)

13% of our members belong to a Grove

67% of our members belong to an Order

30% of Grove members also belong to an Order 4000+ non-registered, "defacto" members (not factored into any percentages)

During the Sixth Year of the Gaian Reform, we experienced a net registration gain of 94

Total Orders Established: 7

Total North American Druids: 712

Nini's Nummies

Peach Spice Cobbler

- 1 16oz bag of Frozen Peaches
- 2 tsp Pumpkin Pie Spice
- 1 box of Spice Cake Mix
- 1 12oz can of Lemon Lime Soda (diet works the same also)

Before opening the peaches try to break them up, since frozen fruit tends to be clumped together when you get them home.

Preheat oven to 350* F and grease a 8x8 with non-stick spray

Take peaches and spread evenly in the pan, then add the pumpkin pie spice and sprinkle all over the peaches. Add the cake mix evenly over the peaches. Pour the sprite over the cake mix. (it will foam but do not mix! mixing makes the top cake like, leaving it will allow the sugar in the soda to caramelize the cake mix.)

Bake for 35-40 or until top is golden and crispy.

Allow to cool for 10-15 minutes, as the peaches will be very warm.
Best served with Whip Cream or Vanilla Ice Cream.
